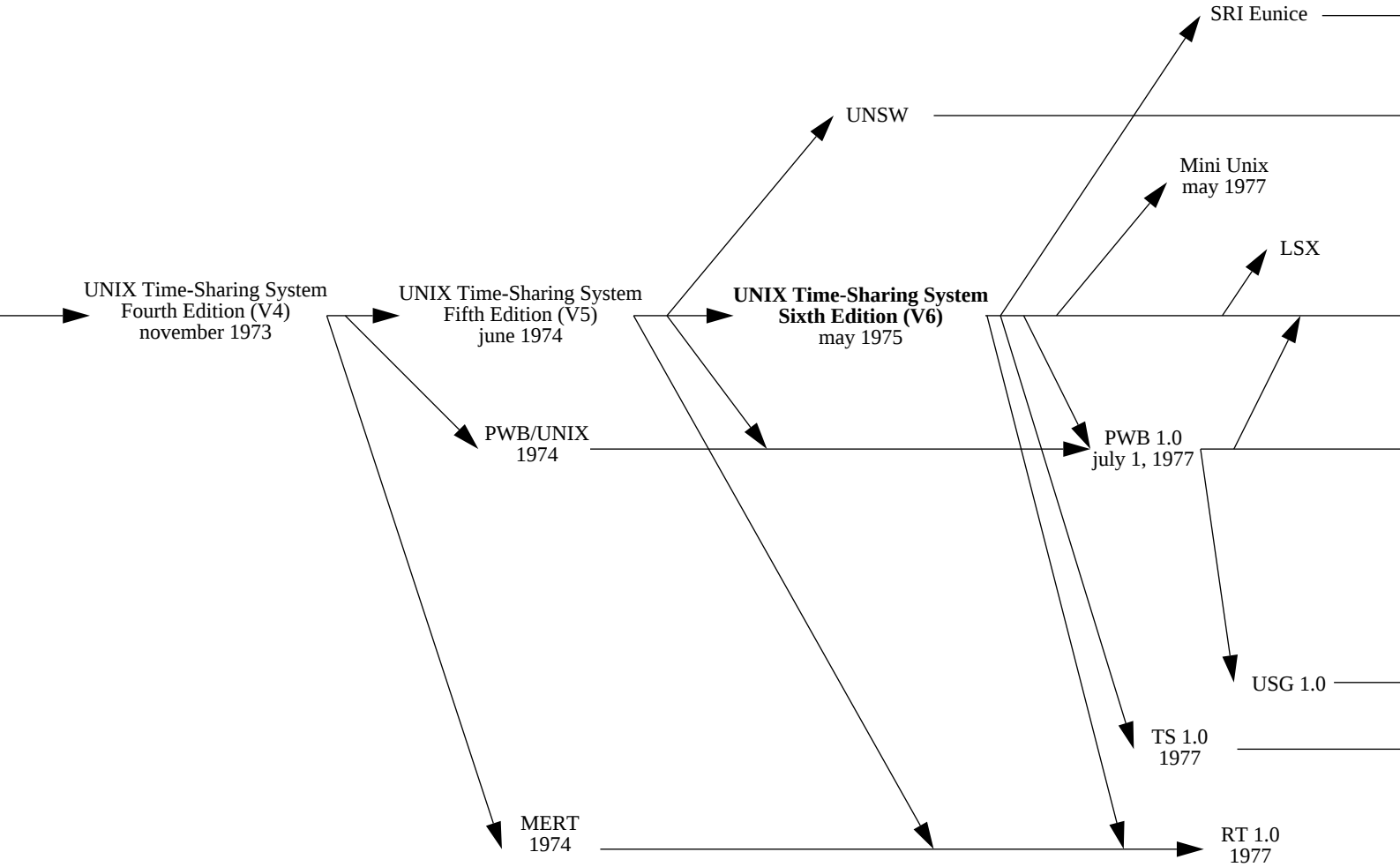

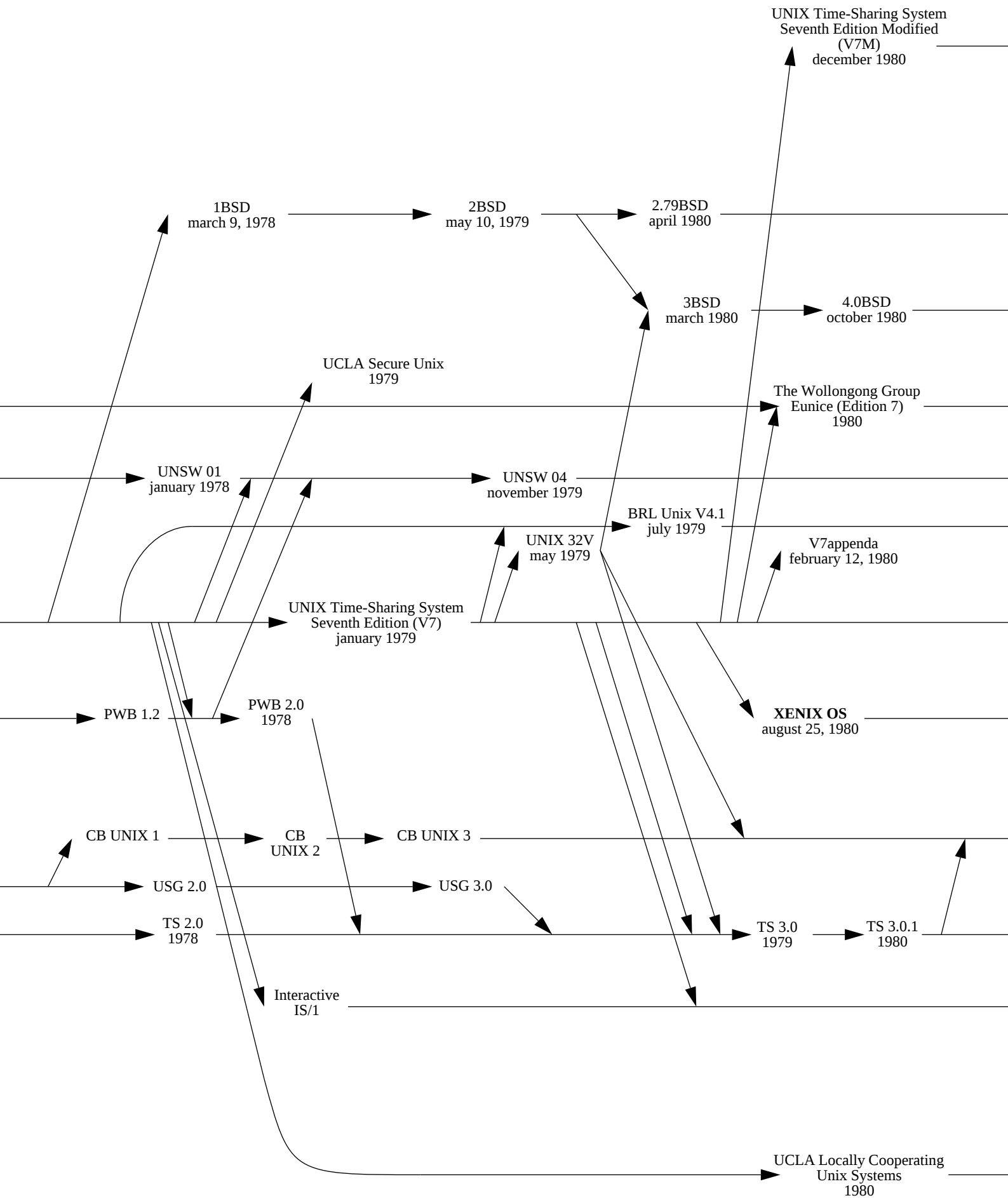

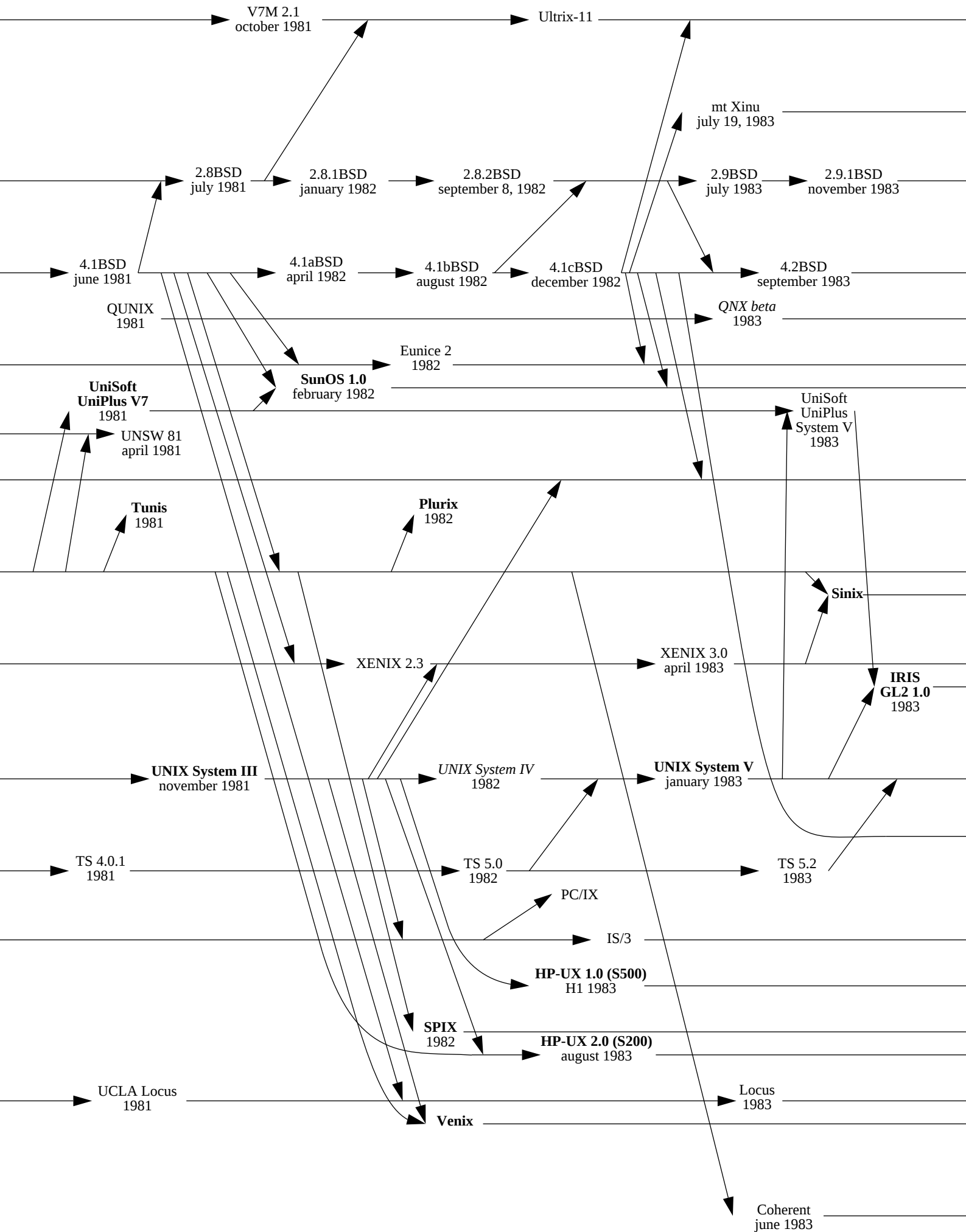
Note 1 : an arrow indicates an inheritance like a compatibility, it is not only a matter of source code.
